This is the best place to find information about our class including homework assignments and test/quiz dates. You can also access the PowerPoint presentations used in class. If you are absent, you can view the slides online and attempt to complete the homework so you will not be behind upon returning to class.

## EXPECTATIONS:

Be prepared for class - bring all materials to class daily and be ready to work.
$\checkmark$ Be in the classroom and in your assigned seat when the bell rings. If you are not prepared for class, then you will be marked tardy.
$\checkmark$ Show respect for yourself, your peers, and the teacher. This includes omitting vulgar or offensive language, or put-downs while in this class.
$\checkmark$ Do your own work. Cheating or copying will not be tolerated. You will receive a zero on the task and your parents will be contacted.
$\checkmark$ Actively participate in class - ask questions and complete all the required work.
$\checkmark$ No food or drink other than bottled water in the classroom.
SUGGESTED SUPPLIES: Supplies should be brought with you to class everyday!

- Pencils \& erasers - Work is to be done in pencil and must be neat and legible. If you need to borrow a pencil, you must do so before the bell.
- Calculator - Not having a calculator will NOT excuse you from doing class work; so if you need it, bring it! We do have a classroom set of graphing calculators that you may sign out for use during class, however you must first get a permission slip signed by your parent/guardian.
- A notebook and folder will be provided for you to keep class notes and worksheets organized. These will be left in the classroom for safe keeping.

ABSENCE POLICY: If you are absent from class, it is your responsibility to find out what you missed. If you miss a quiz or test you will be expected to take the quiz or test the day you return to class. Failure to do so will result in loss of points.

GRADES - There are several ways to earn points in this class. All assessments will be announced in advance; either days before, or at the beginning of the hour.

Always study, practice and ask questions. Be prepared!

1. Tests (40\%) - Tests will be given at the end of each unit or on a collection of units. Expect a test about every three weeks. If you are absent the day of the test, you will be required to make up the test the day you return unless arrangements have been made with the teacher. If you are absent the day or days before the test you are still responsible for taking the test on the assigned day. Retakes are available for this assessment. (Retake, Make-Up, and One Page of Notes)
2. Content Quizzes (30\%) - These assessments will be given in the middle of the unit to assess progress on current material. Students will be asked to complete these quizzes without any notes so an accurate measure of progress can be obtained. Retakes are available for this assessment. (Retake, Make-Up, and No Notes)
3. Homework Quizzes (20\%) - Homework will be assigned on most class days. To your benefit, complete the entire assignment and keep it in your folder, making sure to denote any questions to be answered during class discussion. Some homework problems will be done in class, and there will be time to ask questions. You are responsible for making the necessary corrections on your homework. While daily homework assignments are not graded for correctness by the teacher, homework practice will be assessed by way of quizzes with questions that are similar to the assigned homework problems. You may use your completed homework and/or notes on these assessments. (No make-up, Written notes)
4. Other ( $\mathbf{1 0 \%}$ ) - This category consists of material chosen at the discretion of the teacher but may include journal assignments, bellwork, classwork, and/or projects.

RETAKE POLICY: You have the opportunity to retake content quizzes and tests in this class. However, you must follow this procedure:

1) You must present test corrections to retake the content quiz or test.
2) You must first come to tutoring either during FLEX or before/after school for help on the incorrect problems.
3) The retake must be done within one week of when the assessment is returned to the class.
4) At the teacher's discretion, when retaking a test you will be asked to use no notes or to use the original reference sheet.
5) At the teacher's discretion, a parent signature could be required in order for a content quiz and/or test to be retaken.
